Easily accessible via Dublin's public transport: several bus routes and the Luas tram service have stops near Temple Bar. Limited street parking is available around Temple Bar, but there are several nearby parking garages.

## Accessibility

Our museum is fully accessible to visitors with disabilities. There are no stairs to enter the building and there is a lift and ramps to ensure all exhibition spaces are reachable within the museum. We have a disabled toilet available upon request.

Service, assistant and emotional support animals are more than welcome.

We have implemented a Hearing Loop System at the reception and visual aids are available on demand.

We also have sensory borrow bags and communication cards at the reception as well as pre-visit materials such as a sensory map and a visual guide downloadable on our accessibility webpage.

The quietest times to visit our Museum are when the galleries first open between 11.00 and 12.00 and again in the afternoon after 16.00.
